This file was referred for preparation of a cost projection for future medical care and treatment for Nancy Rose, secondary to injuries sustained on July 2, 2017. ### **Diagnoses:**

- Disc herniations at C6-C7 impinging on the thecal sac
- Disc bulge at C3-C4 and C5-C6 impinging on the thecal sac
- Acute right sided radiculopathy at C7 confirmed by EMG/NCV
- Disc bulge at L4-L5 impinging upon the left neural foramen
- Severe axial cervical and lumbar
- Severe radicular cervical pain
- Cervical and sacral non-allopathic lesions
- Cervical/lumbar sprain/strain

- Cervicalgia/lumbago
- Cervical/lumbar myospasm
- Lumbar facet joint syndrome
- Lumbar sciatica
- 1. Regarding permanency, pain management specialist, Alexander Z., M.D. stated, "Based on the residuals I see at the time of the examination, I am of the medical opinion the findings are permanent in character, and the overall prognosis is poor in as much as this accident has significantly affected her daily activities. In all medical probability, Ms. Rose will require further treatment for the symptomatology that has arisen from the injuries sustained in the July 2, 2017 motor vehicle accident. These changes are permanent."
- 2. Regarding future treatment, Dr. Z. stated, "With regards to the cervical and lumbar discs, plaintiff will require epidural steroids at a rate of 3 injections per year in both her cervical and lumbar discs. These findings are permanent."
- 3. Ms. Rose will require office visits the day of and for follow up after procedures. The treating pain management specialist will determine the frequency of intervention based on results. Per Dr. Z, she can have up to 3 per year for permanent cervical and lumbar disc injuries.
- 4. Per ODG and VA/DoD guidelines, non-medical intervention can include massage, acupuncture, chiropractic, swim therapy or supervised exercises for self-directed symptom management, strengthening and conditioning. Ms. Rose can access these modalities without a prescription as needed.

Based on a reasonable degree of cost projection analysis, the future care of Ms. Nancy Rose includes:
